

INJECTION GUIDELINES

STEROID AND SPECIALIZED INJECTIONS ARE DONE ON SPECIFIC DAYS.

EVALUATE FOR IODINE ALLERGY AND USE OF BLOOD THINNING MEDICATIONS INCLUDING ASPIRIN.

- IF PATIENT HAS IODINE ALLERGY – ASK RADIOLOGIST IF INJECTION CAN BE DONE WITHOUT IODINE OR IF PATIENT NEEDS TO BE BLOCKED.
- IF PATIENT TAKING COUMADIN – INR MUST BE <3
- ASPIRIN MUST BE DISCONTINUED FOR 10 DAYS PRIOR TO INJECTION.
